Referral Process: We are committed to making the referral process to our practice as efficient as possible for you and your staff. Upon receiving your referral, our patient care representatives will promptly call your patient to choose the most convenient location and appointment time for them, and to go over their visit preparation instructions. We will notify you via fax with the patient's chosen appointment time. We will also notify you if your patient misses their appointment, or declines their appointment for any reason. After the patient is seen, we work hard to ensure you receive our follow up note regarding your patient within a timely manner.

All new patients will have an initial consultation and evaluation with our physicians to establish individual testing and treatment indications. Testing, procedures, and treatments may require additional visits. Common allergy testing and lung function testing are offered at the initial appointment when indicated. We advise our new patients to stop taking all antihistamine medications (not nose sprays or inhalers) for 5 days before their new patient appointment. If they are unable to do so, they should continue their medications, and the physician will discuss alternative medications, testing, or later testing at their initial appointment.
